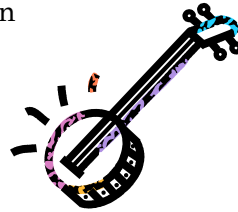

Pickin' Party Music Festival at The Homeplace

Celebrate the 50th Anniversary of Land Between The Lakes with us at our **15th Annual Pickin' Party Old-time Music Festival** at The Homeplace.

Throughout the day, stroll through our historic buildings, fields and gardens as the music lofts in the background. Talk with the 1850's farm family as they go about their daily chores. We've planned **children's activities** for extra fun!

Bring lawn chairs, ground blankets, coolers, and snacks to relax. **Bring your banjo, guitar, fiddle, harmonica, or other instruments** to play!

Mark Dvorak: A great folk singer, fretless banjo picker, and blues guitar performer returns this year, as do the **Dixie Volunteers**, one of our favorite **Old-time String Bands**.

Common Thread will perform traditional songs once again for us all.

Thomas Maupin & Daniel Rothwell with the Overall Creek Band:

Descending from a long line of buck dancers, **Thomas Maupin** continues the tradition as a legendary buck dancer in a flat foot style. His honors include the 2011 TN State Governor's Folklife

Heritage Award and Uncle Dave Macon Trailblazer Award. His grandson, **Daniel Rothwell**, a 2010 National Banjo Champion, provides lively banjo tunes for his grandfather. The **Overall Creek Band** includes Daniel's father, **Danny**, on guitar and legendary base player **Jackie Case** with his percussive "slap" technique. Enjoy this toe tapping performance as three generations keep Tennessee's rich music traditions alive.

Roan Mountain Hilltoppers: This Appalachian Mountain String Band brings the sounds of Roan Mountain to The Homeplace. **Bill and Janice Birchfield** keep the music traditions started by Bill's family over 30 years ago. This high energy string band includes Bill playing fiddle, banjo, and autoharp; Janice on wash board; **Terry** on guitar; and **Josh** on banjo. Tap away to these traditional dancing tunes and songs.
